Candidates may include state and local political leaders, regulatory officials, legislators, state agency directors, corporations, or other policymakers who have been exceptional in their support of energy efficiency.

Nomination Form Guidelines

This is an active PDF. You may type directly in to the fields. Fill in the form below, completing the contact information of the nominee and your contact information as the nominator. The second page is where you will provide your reason for nomination, making your most compelling case. Please address as many of the following criterion as possible in your description:

- The candidate has been involved in a series of decisions – not just a single decision – that have impacted energy efficiency broadly across the Midwest.
- Candidates have chosen a difficult path in defense of energy efficiency when other choices could have been more politically expedient or personally rewarding.
- Nominees have either set a new standard or taken a new and controversial position within their respective community – whether it is the efficiency community, the legislative or regulatory policy maker community or another.

The total length of this form, once complete, should not exceed 2 pages total. You may attach up to 3 sets of additional materials (graphics, evaluation data, other creative materials and endorsements) but the number of pages per attachment should not exceed 1 page.
