

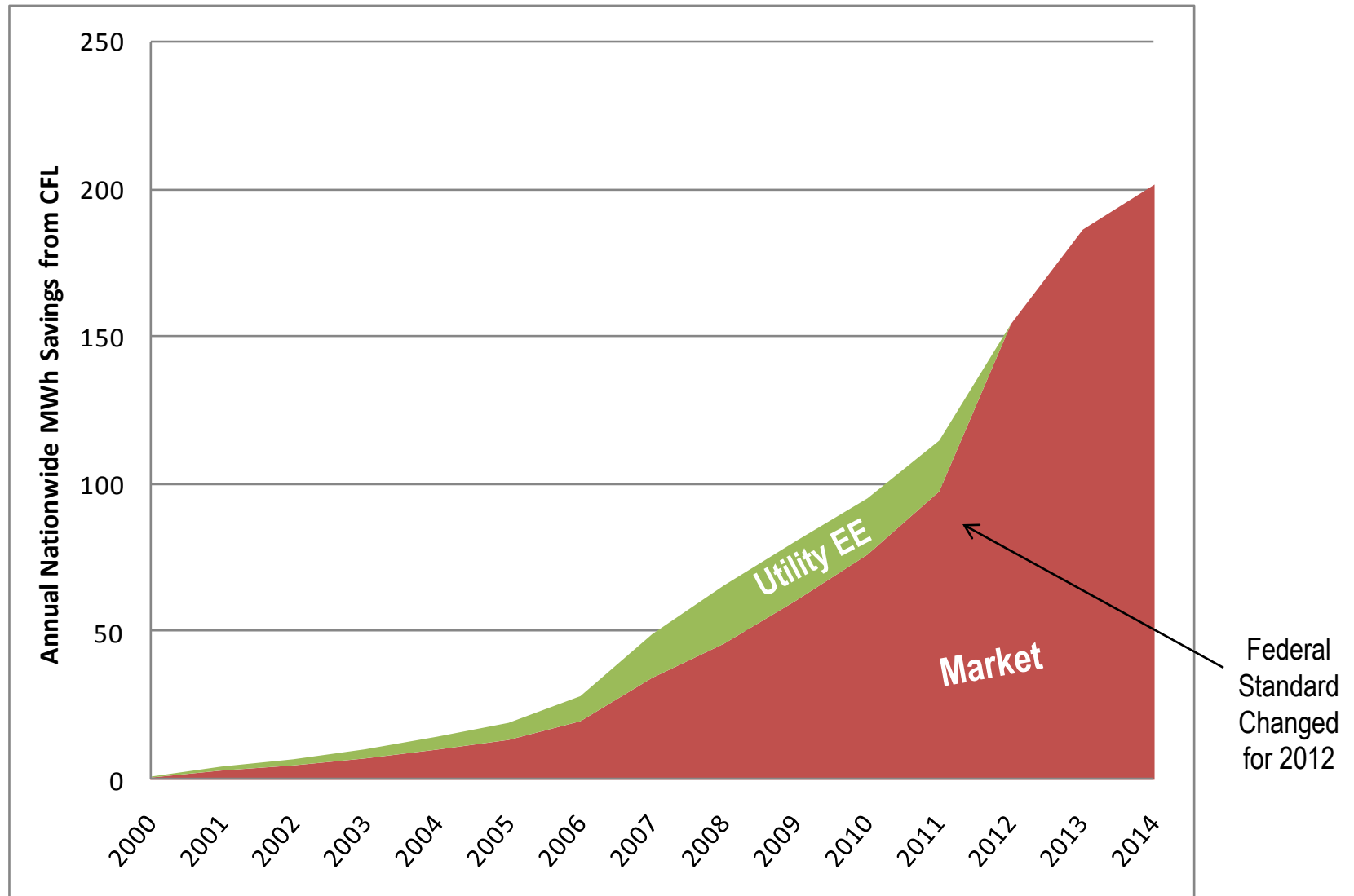

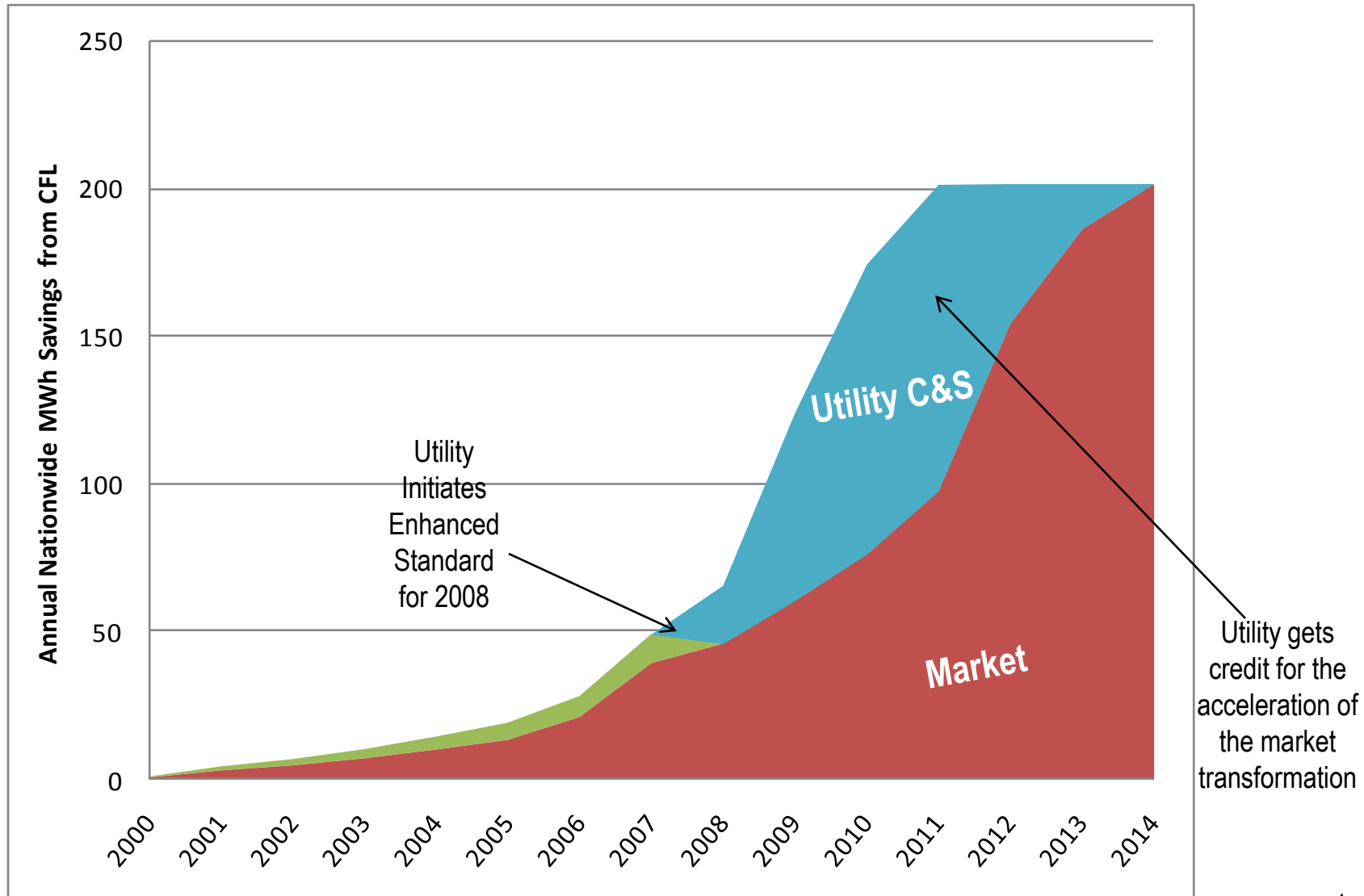
# Codes and Standards

- Building Codes specify minimum efficiency levels for new building construction projects (e.g. 2006 IECC codes for insulation, windows)
- Appliance Standards are regulations that define minimum efficiency rate for new appliance sales. (e.g. lighting, refrigerator, HVAC standards)
- Code and Standards mandates reduce the market for utility programs, i.e. utility market potential.
- Codes And Standards Enhancement (CASE) programs enable utilities to proactively enhance codes and standards to achieve energy savings
